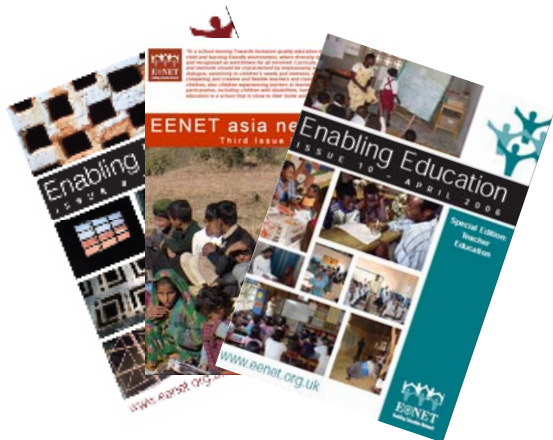
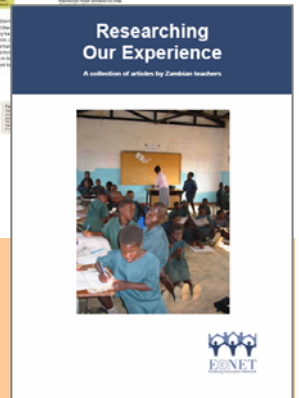
What is EENET?
