

Preparing Teachers for Inclusive Education

The Lesotho Video

A video-based training package for use on in-service and pre-service teacher training courses.

The video package has three main aims:

- to provide class-room based models of good practice for teachers
- to support local trainers of teachers
- to share information about inclusive education.

All the video footage was recorded on location throughout Lesotho in both rural and urban schools. The videos draw on the experience and practice of Basotho teachers.

The training package consists of 13 video-programmes, totalling over four hours and arranged in four parts, each dealing with a specific theme in inclusive education:

- Foundations
- Overcoming Impairments
- Adapting the Curriculum
- Responding to Difference.

A guide is provided for teacher trainers in using the materials. This contains recommended learning activities for use with course participants. Many of these activities have been developed in the training workshops carried out by the Special Education Unit during the pilot phase of the project.
